- Public benefits like Medicaid, SSI, food stamps, TANF, WIC
- Custody, guardianship, establishing paternity
- Housing and utility issues
- Education needs

## What is HeLP?

HeLP is a partnership between doctors and lawyers to help patients and their families with legal issues. HeLP is a free service. You do not need a referral from a doctor, social worker, or hospital staff to reach out to HeLP.

## Who can get HeLP?

You can get HeLP if:

- Your child receives care at any Children's Healthcare of Atlanta location;
- Your family lives at or below 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Level; and
- Your legal problem is the kind that we handle.

If you don't know if you meet these requirements, call us to find out.

## How do I get HeLP?

1. Call us at 404-785-2005. If we don't answer, please leave a message with your name, phone number, and why you are calling. We will call you back.
2. Complete an application. This can be done over the phone.
3. Send in any paperwork that the HeLP staff asks for.
